William and Jane had 10 children of which only 1 was born in NSW in 1857. The children were: Elizabeth, Anne, Maria, James Pardy, John, Francis, Samuel, William Pardy, Jane and Susan Adeline (who was the one born in NSW).

**PARKINSON** – (Garrett Wellesley PARKINSON born c 1823 Ennis, co Clare and his wife Harriett Jane LINDSAY. He was originally a Sub Inspector in the Royal Irish Constabulary later appointed Resident Magistrate of Galway about 1865, the family then moved to Clifden. Children were Rebecca Harriet 1857- 1890, Garrett Wellesley 1858, Martin LINDSAY 1860 - 1860, Annie Mira 1862 - 1869, Maria Susan Amy 1864 - aft.1928, Violet Lindsay 1867- abt. 1895 , Harriette Constance Mary 1869-1891. After his wife' s death he married Eleanor TUFFIELD in 1872 and had Henriette Florence in 1875. **PAYNE/PAINE/PAIN/PANE**, Galway, Dublin, London, Gloucestershire, Virginia; 1600' s; (John Payne, master of the John and Dorothy that came to port in Galway during the late 1630' s from Virginia. John Payne was arrested for selling the cargo of his partner, Joseph Hawes, there and was detained in jail for about a year according to PRO records I have found. At the time of the court proceedings in London, one of the deponents stated that John Payne was currently residing in Dublin. That record was from the early 1640' s and a commission was sent to Ireland for the case. Since John was imprisoned, his boat impounded, and a lengthy trial ensued, I am hoping there are some records on him available. John appears to have been a member of a large family of Payne merchant/mariners during this time as I have found records naming no less than 4 Payne' s as masters and/or part owners of the John and Dorothy, as well as several other ships. The family seems to have ties in Gloucestershire and/or London and may have been involved with the London Company or one of its constituents as Payne' s are frequently mentioned in those records or can be found with men associated with it such as, John Winslow and John Martin. Additionally, two Payne' s are named in the 1609 2nd Charter of Virginia- Sir Robert Payne and William Payne. **PONIARD**, Castle Lambert, Athenry, 1821-1892, (This family was of French descent (name variants include PONARD, PUNARD, PUNIARD, PUNYARD), arriving in Galway cir 1820 at the invitation of Capt LAMBERT, who was hired by the English to control property. This first known settler to Ireland, from France was named James PONIARD, who married Sarah MONAGHAN. They had numerous children, including sons, Michael, Anthony, Darby and Hubert. Anthony & Darby came to America cir 1850 and settled in Charleston, SC. Interestingly, they both enlisted in the Confederate Artillery from South Carolina during the Civil War. Darby was one of 52 fatalities at Ft Sumter during the entire 4 years of seige warfare, he died in July 1864 from a Parrot Shell fragment. Anthony survived the war and died in 1888 and is buried in St Lawrence cemetery in Charleston, SC. Darby spelled his name PUNIARD, while Anthony spelled his name as PONARD. Hubert emigrated to Australia in the 1850's and has left descendants there. Michael (my ancestor) remained in Ireland, and had numerous children, one of which was my great grandmother, Catherine (PONIARD) QUALTERS, 1860-1929. Catherine came to America with her husband Martin QUALTERS, shortly after they were married in Athenry on July 9th, 1892.), Keith W.
